The slide will be posted for each lot of cattle but if the cattle are 51# to 75# over base weight the slide will increase by \$1.00/cwt, if the cattle are 76# or more over the base weight the slide will increase \$2.00/cwt otherwise the slide will remain as stated in the catalog.</u>
